ORDINANCE # 797

AN ORDINANCE TO POSTPONE THE IMPLEMENTATION REVISED VALUES RESULTING FROM THE EQUALIZATION PROGRAM (REASSESSMENT)

WHEREAS, Marlboro County is required per Section 12-43-217 of the 1976 Code, to appraise and equalize properties under its jurisdiction once every fifth year; and

WHEREAS, said code has been amended to allow postponement for not more than one property tax year the implementation of revised values resulting from the equalization program; and

WHEREAS, the postponement applies to all revised values, including values for state-appraised property; and


WHEREAS, Marlboro County Council deems the postponement necessary for proper evaluation of revised values under the direction of South Carolina Department of Revenue.


THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, the Marlboro County Council hereby authorizes postponement of the implementation of the appraisal and equalization of properties under its jurisdiction for not more than one property tax year, that said postponement applies to all revised values, including values for state-appraised property, and that said postponement does not affect the schedule of the appraisal and equalization program referred pursuant to South Carolina Code 12-43-217 as amended.
